Glossary:

- Call Time: This is the time that we ask you to be onsite. We check each person in, communicate any new information, and plan on this time to make sure everyone is warmed up and ready to go once rehearsal starts. We know you're excited but we ask you to come at the time specified and not earlier. We use this schedule to plan our staffing and dressing room space and we want to make sure that we are ready for you!
- **Rehearsal:** These time blocks are the overall windows that you will be rehearsing with us. There will be some down time during these rehearsal blocks and time provided for breaks. We ask that you be patient during these times, it takes a lot of different pieces to put the show together and we promise to use your time as effectively as possible

• Costume Fittings: This is where you get to try on the different costumes you will be wearing in the show and we get to make sure they fit you properly!

Rehearsals are subject to change, and we will provide as much notice as possible. More details about rehearsals will be provided at least two weeks in advance and will include:

- Maps and Directions
- Where and how to check in
- What to bring (and what not to bring!)

- Friends or Family: This is a reminder that all rehearsals are closed to spectators. We understand that some parents will be dropping off and picking up performers; parents will be able to wait in the entrance foyer or return after rehearsal.

Call Times and Departures:

We use this schedule to plan our staffing and dressing room space and we want to make sure that we are ready for you!
- Please note that cast are occasionally asked to stay after rehearsal for notes or additional fittings. We do our best to make these as efficient as possible but we ask for your patience as we work through these crucial details. Cast members will need to be officially released by our team before they depart the venue.

Time is short! We have a very limited rehearsal schedule and every rehearsal is vital to producing a great show! As such, every rehearsal is mandatory in order to participate in the performance.

Closed Rehearsals

All of our rehearsals and backstage areas are closed to the public: that includes family and friends. Parents and guardians of minors will be asked to leave once their child has checked in with our team.
